SENIORS

Seniors can not play in JV games, but they can practice with the JV team. Any seniors not able to meet the varsity requirements at tryouts will be given the opportunity to practice with the JV team until the coaches have determined they are able to meet the varsity requirements and can keep up at a varsity level. Playing time is never guaranteed!

We are one of the only sports at West Ranch to offer a M-Th practice schedule. We have found that giving the athletes one night a week to focus on homework, social events or family commitments allows the girls the ability to dedicate all of their attention during practice and reduces absences. In order for this to work, everyone must be in attendance Monday-Thursday. If an athlete has a test or project they need to manage their time properly and use their day off on Friday to complete the project or study. This means we do not accept "too much homework" or "I have a project tomorrow" as an excused absence.




